## Why Volunteer As A Mentor?

- One in four college students with disabilities gain employment upon graduation
- Mentors make a real IMPACT on students' futures through mentoring
- Sharing professional and life experience helps students develop skills, competency, and goals
- Mentors guide students to become stronger self-advocates
- Mentors make a difference by sharing accumulated knowledge and expertise

## What Do Mentors Do?

- Make a 10-Week Commitment to a Student Mentee
- Meet Virtually with Mentee at Least 2 Hours per Month
- Attend Online Mentor Orientation and Disability Awareness Training
- Find Support Through Online Round Tables with Shared Experiences and Resources (1hr/mo)
- Attend the Afternoon Celebration Ceremony for Students Successfully Completing the Program
- Invited to Attend *CareerReady!* Program Online Courses
